Notice is hereby given as required by Title 5, Chapter 551.041 of the Government Code that the Argyle Town Council will meet in a Town Council Special Meeting on January 28, 2021 at 6:00 PM at the Argyle Town Hall, 308 Denton Street, Argyle, Texas.

One or more members of the Town Council may participate in this meeting remotely in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act or under the provisions provided by the Governor of Texas in conjunction with the Declaration of Disaster enacted March 13, 2020.

In an effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people into a group setting and in accordance with Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code, telephonic capabilities will be utilized. CALL TO ORDER

OPEN FORUM

This is an opportunity for the public to address the Town Council on any matter of public business, except public hearings. Comments related to public hearings will be heard when the specific hearing begins. Each speaker is limited to five (5) minutes, unless the speaker requires the assistance of a translator, in which case the speaker is limited to ten (10) minutes, in accordance with applicable law. Each speaker shall approach the podium and state their name. Speakers shall address the governing body with civility that is conducive to appropriate public discussion. Speakers can address only the governing body as a whole and not individual city officials or employees. The public cannot speak from the gallery but only from the podium. Per the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Town Council is prohibited from deliberating or taking action on any matter not listed on the agenda. The Council may only: (1) make a statement of fact regarding the item; (2) make a recitation of existing policy regarding the item; or (3) propose the item be placed on a future agenda, in accordance with Council adopted procedures.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Pursuant to Texas Government Code, Annotated, Chapter 551, Subchapter D, Texas Open Meetings Act (the "Act"), Town Council will recess into Executive Session (closed meeting) to discuss the following:

Personnel Matters

§551.074: Personnel matters (to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee):

1. Planning and Zoning Commission Interviews

In accordance with Texas Government Code, Section 551, the Town Council will reconvene into Open Session and consider action, if any, on matters discussed in Executive Session.

NOTE: As authorized by Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code (Consultation with Town Attorney), this meeting may be convened into closed Executive Session for the purpose of seeking confidential legal advice from the Town Attorney on any agenda item herein.

A quorum of the members of the Planning and Zoning Commission, Economic Development Corporation, and Crime Control Prevention District may be in attendance at this meeting.
The boards/commissions will take no action during the course of this meeting.
