ARGYLE, TX (August 15, 2021) – The Municipal Development District held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, September 14, 2021. At this meeting, board members received an update on retail recruitment progress from the Retail Coach. The Retail Coach recently attended and represented the Town of Argyle at Retail Live, a retail recruitment conference in Austin. Town Administrator Rich Olson presented a list of retailers that are currently looking to expand, ranging from the likes of Dunkin Donuts to Target and Lowes. Additionally, Retail Coach provided the Town with a list of five retailers who expressed interest in locating to Argyle. These retailers were further discussed in closed session.

Argyle Business Association

Town Communications Coordinator Julia Falcon gave board members an update on the progress made on the Argyle Business Association. Since announcing the official relaunch on August 16, 2021, the Online Business Directory has grown, and businesses have been engaging for the Business Spotlight. The first Business Spotlight is Point Bank, who will be hosting the inaugural Coffee Networking event on Thursday, September 30, from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. Board President Cynthia Hermann will be speaking at the event.

Budget

At the Town Council meeting on September 7, Council held the public hearing for the Town's Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget. This budget will be approved at the next Council meeting on September 20. The MDD board did approve the budget for the MDD, which includes splitting payment for a drone, per the Police Department's request.

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
