Town of Argyle to Enforce Fee to Return Confiscated Signs

ARGYLE, TX (August 23, 2022) – Starting September 1, 2022, Town of Argyle Staff will be enforcing a \$50 fee to return an illegally placed sign confiscated by a Town Personnel.

The Town's Development Standards specify that any sign that is erected, constructed or maintained on public property, such as public right-of-way, in violation of the Town Regulations, is subject to confiscation by Town personnel. The Town will retain the confiscated signs for a period of seven calendar days from the date of confiscation. Confiscated signs may be reclaimed by the owner within the seven-day retention period provided that an administrative fee of \$50.00 is paid. However, the Town has not been enforcing this fee in the recent years.

"Staff has determined that enforcing this will help raise awareness within the community and ensure less instances of illegally placed signs." Community Development Director Nabila Nur said. "It is important that we uphold the Town's regulations in maintaining the quality appearance for the Town that we are proud of".

Staff advises that the Town can be reached out at 940-464-7273 to reclaim a confiscated sign by paying the \$50 fee.
