JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Court that the State of Texas, for the use and benefit of the Town of Argyle, Denton County, Texas, do have and recover from the Defendant the amount of \$_____, being the fine plus costs, less jail credit in the amount of \$_____, for a total balance due of \$_____. Such fine and court costs are due no later than 30 days (_____) from the date of this Order.

It is further ordered that if the Defendant defaults in the discharge of this Judgment and a Capias Pro Fine warrant for arrest is issued according to Texas law and the Defendant is placed in jail, then pursuant to Article 45.048(b) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the Court specifies that after conducting a commitment hearing, the Defendant remain in jail a sufficient length of time to satisfy the fine and costs at the following rate: *not less than eight hours or more than 24 hours* to earn a *minimum dollar amount of \$100* to satisfy the fine and costs. If the Defendant cannot pay the full amount of the fine and costs in full, there are alternatives available, including extensions, payments plans and non-monetary alternatives with sufficient proof of financial condition. Please contact the court clerk for more information. The Defendant has the right to appeal a judgment or conviction.
