ARGYLE, TX (May 18, 2021) –During the Town Council meeting Monday night, Council voted to appoint Councilmember Ronald Schmidt as Mayor Pro Tem (MPT). “I’m proud and humbled to be nominated and appointed as Mayor Pro Tem,” Schmidt said. “I look forward to accepting the responsibilities that come along with the post, and to continue to put the citizens of Argyle first in the governance of our town and to serve them with the utmost dedication.” With the election of Mayor Livingston, a vacancy has occurred with Council seat Place 1. The Council will be establishing a policy on how to fill vacant seats on Town Council and other appointed boards.

At the Town Council meeting last night, Council recognized the Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools 2021 Wrestling State Champions, the Liberty Christian School Warriors. The team was crowned state champion on April 10, 2021 with 208 points. The Warriors Wrestling Team has won five of the last eight state titles for their class of school.

Planning & Zoning Action Items

In the Town Council meeting Monday, Council also approved the preliminary and final plats located in Canyon Falls Village 9-AR, a 42.58-acre, 54 single-family lot subdivision located in the Town’s extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) off Stonecrest Road. The approval came with two conditions recommended by the Planning & Zoning Commission.

Below are the conditions:

1. That a pedestrian crossing be created on the twenty (20’) foot gas pipeline easement owned by Barnett Gathering LP midway through the block on Canyon Point and Fireside Drive per Section 2.05 “Blocks” of the Town Engineering Ordinance 1989-4.
2. Approval of the preliminary plat and final plat is contingent on the determination of Denton County that the proposed plats comply with the access requirements of the 2015 International Fire Code.
