### **Budget Hearing**

Council voted unanimously to schedule a public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget. The hearing will be held during the next Council meeting on September 7, 2021 at Town Hall at 6 p.m.

### **Tax Freeze**

In a special [budget meeting on July 26, 2021](#), Council recommended that there be a tax freeze put in place for senior citizens and those who are disabled. In the Council meeting on Monday, August 16, Council unanimously approved the Limited Increases of Ad Valorem Taxes on Residence Homesteads for Persons Age 65 and Over and Disabled Persons.

### **Town Engineer**

At the Town Council meeting on Monday, Council approved to appoint Freese and Nichols as the Town's engineer, entering a professional services agreement with the company. In correlation with this appointment, Council also unanimously approved the notice of intention to issue certificates of obligation.

### **Consent Agenda Items**

Council gave unanimous consent on items two through 10 on the agenda Monday night. Of those items, Council approved the appointment of members to the Crime Control & Prevention District board and acted to schedule October 4, 2021 to conduct interviews for the Planning & Zoning Commission board Places 2, 4 and 6.
