ARGYLE, TX (October 1, 2021) – The Town of Argyle is proud to announce the celebration of the third annual Arbor Day celebration event. Celebrating Arbor Day is required to maintain the Tree City USA certification, which Argyle was awarded for the second time in 2020.

Like last year's event, BPS Technology will be hosting a drive-through style event with the Town of Argyle. The event will be held at BPS' location in Argyle – 151 FM 407 E, Argyle, TX 76226, on Saturday, November 6, 2021 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Since this falls on the same day as Mornings with the Mayor, Mayor Bryan Livingston will have a table for residents to chat and grab coffee and donuts as they drive through and pick up their tree. In addition to the tree giveaway on November 6, Mayor Livingston and Argyle ISD Superintendent Dr. Telena Wright will be dedicating four trees at Unity Park on November 5 at 1 p.m.

“Argyle's rural, small-town charm is anchored in our location on the western edge of the Cross Timbers,” said Argyle Mayor Bryan Livingston. “We are proud to once again be named Tree City USA and to celebrate the fact that over 30% of the town's 11 square miles is under tree canopy.”

Starting October 4, residents living in the Argyle Town limits and the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) can sign up for a time slot to pick up a Tuskegee Crape Myrtle, Southern Wax Myrtle, Texas Red Oak, White Oak or Basham's Party Pink tree, limit one per household. Stay tuned to the town's social media accounts for more information as it comes out.
