ARGYLE, TX (November 2, 2021) – During the Town Council meeting on Monday, November 1, 2021, Mayor Bryan Livingston proclaimed that November 6, 2021 will be Arbor Day in the Town of Argyle. To maintain the Tree City USA designation, one requirement is the completion of a proclamation and annual Arbor Day event. This year, the Argyle Arbor Day and Tree Giveaway event will be held on Saturday, November 6, 2021. A drive-thru tree giveaway will be held at BPS Technology. Prior to this event, on Friday, November 5, 2021, leaders of the Town and Argyle Independent School District will be dedicating four trees in Unity Park off of Crawford Road. If approved by the Arbor Day Foundation, 2021 will mark the 3rd straight year that the Town of Argyle will be recognized as a Tree City USA local government organization.

Code Enforcement Activity Report

Community Development Director Emilio Sanchez presented the Council with Code Enforcement activity from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. During this timeframe, notably, there were 444 bandit signs (signs without a permit) removed and 374 cases of stop work construction after hours. There were a total of 968 cases.

Traffic Enforcement Activity Report

Argyle Police Chief Emmitt Jackson presented the Council with an overview of traffic enforcement activities in 2021. The most common roadways where traffic enforcement occurs is at Crawford Road, Old Justin Road/Old Justin and US 377. Hickory Hill Road, Gibbons Road and Harpole Road. There were a total of 471 traffic complaints, driven by requests from citizens to control speeding and other improper motorist behaviors, like improper turns. Approximately 46% of stops end up with a citation and 54% end up with a warning.

Task Order of the Town Engineer

During the Council meeting Monday evening, Council approved the execution of Task Order No. 2 with Freese and Nichols (FNI) for the review of TDS-21-007, Land Use Tables and Definitions. These amendments were previously tabled at the November 2, 2020 Council meeting.
