ARGYLE, TX (April 5, 2022) – During the Town Council meeting on Monday, April 4, 2022, the Town Council approved a budget amendment for fiscal year 2021-22 to appropriate \$366,470 from the Street Maintenance and Repair Special Revenue Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of funding the Stonecrest Street Rehabilitation project. There will be a public meeting on April 21 to further discuss the timeline and detour routes.

#### **TEX-21 Coalition**

The Town Council approved joining the TEX-21 coalition and appointment Councilmember Rick Bradford as the town's representative. TEX-21 (Transportation Excellence for the 21st Century) is a collective, grassroots effort to improve transportation and trade infrastructure in the States of Texas and Oklahoma. The Town of Argyle has been invited to become a member of this coalition at an annual cost of \$2,500, based on population.

#### **Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds**

The Town Council discussed possible uses for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CLFRF). The town received notification in July that we were eligible to receive CLFRF funds in the amount of \$1,085,550. The Council discussed potentially using it as grant money for small businesses.
