MDD Appointments

Town Council appointed two new members to the Municipal Development District board. Dr. Leona McDade has been appointed to Place 6 and Larry Thompson has been appointed to Place 7. Dr. McDade has served on the Argyle Planning & Zoning Commission and is a member of the Argyle ISD school board. Thompson works in the aerospace industry in Plano. The two terms will expire October 31, 2023.

Termination of Reytech contract

The Town Council approved the termination of contract with Reytech for nonperformance. Reytech was contracted by the town for Phase 1 of the US 377 Sewer Line Relocation project but have since gone bankrupt and are no longer in business.

Drainage

Council discussed drainage issues within the community and the possibility of creating a stormwater utility some time in the future to help address a number of these concerns.

Slogan campaign

The Town Council has expressed interest in coming up with a slogan to represent the town as a part of its brand. Councilmembers will seek ideas from the public in the next few weeks for a potential slogan.
